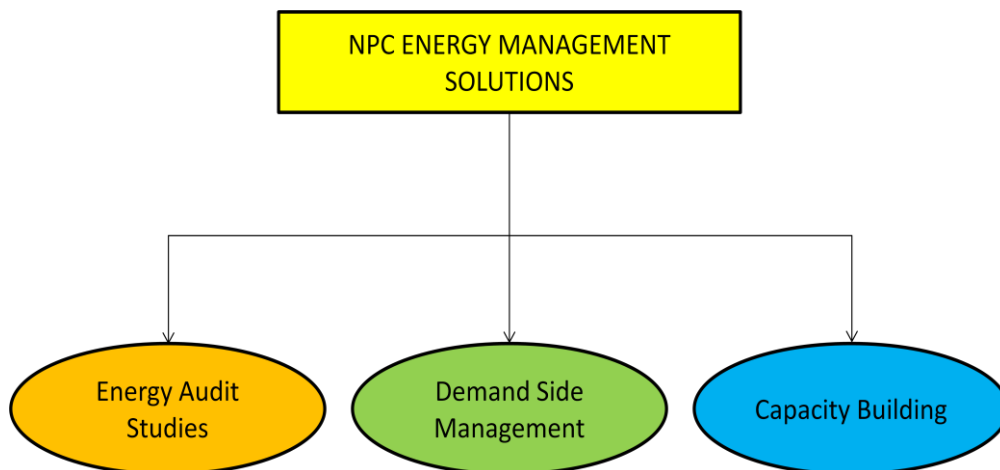


NPC – ENERGY MANAGEMENT SERVICES
